

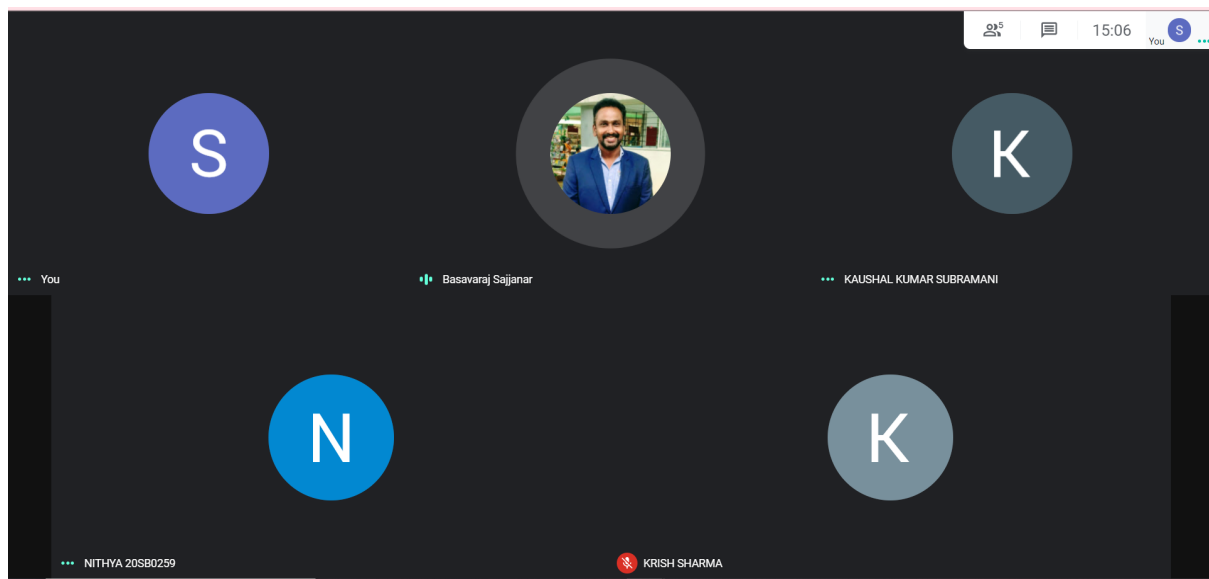
CAS PROJECT: GROUP 1

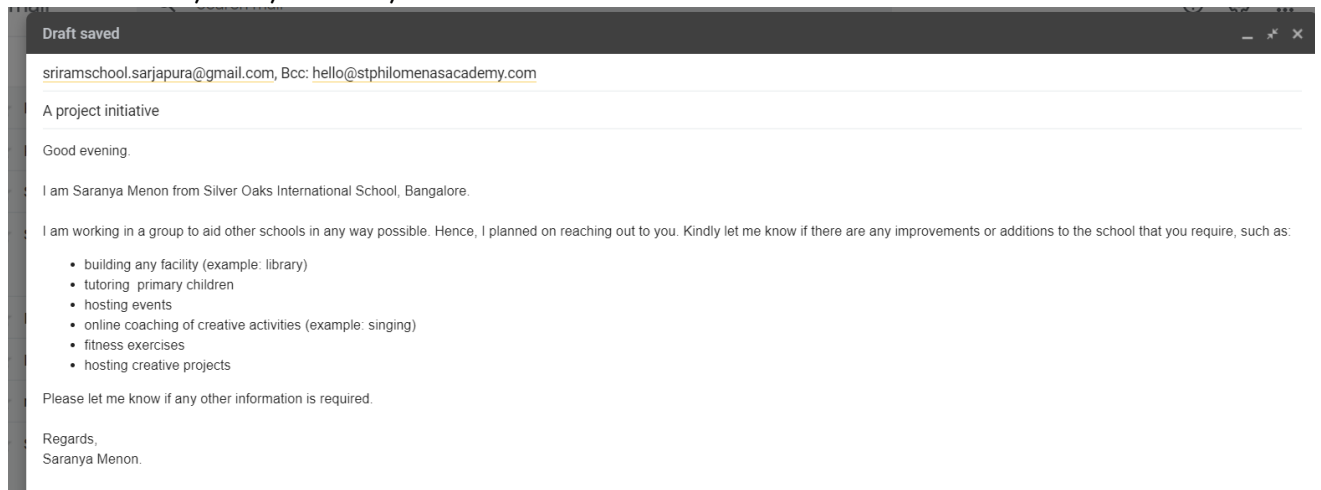

Other options (after visiting sources) -

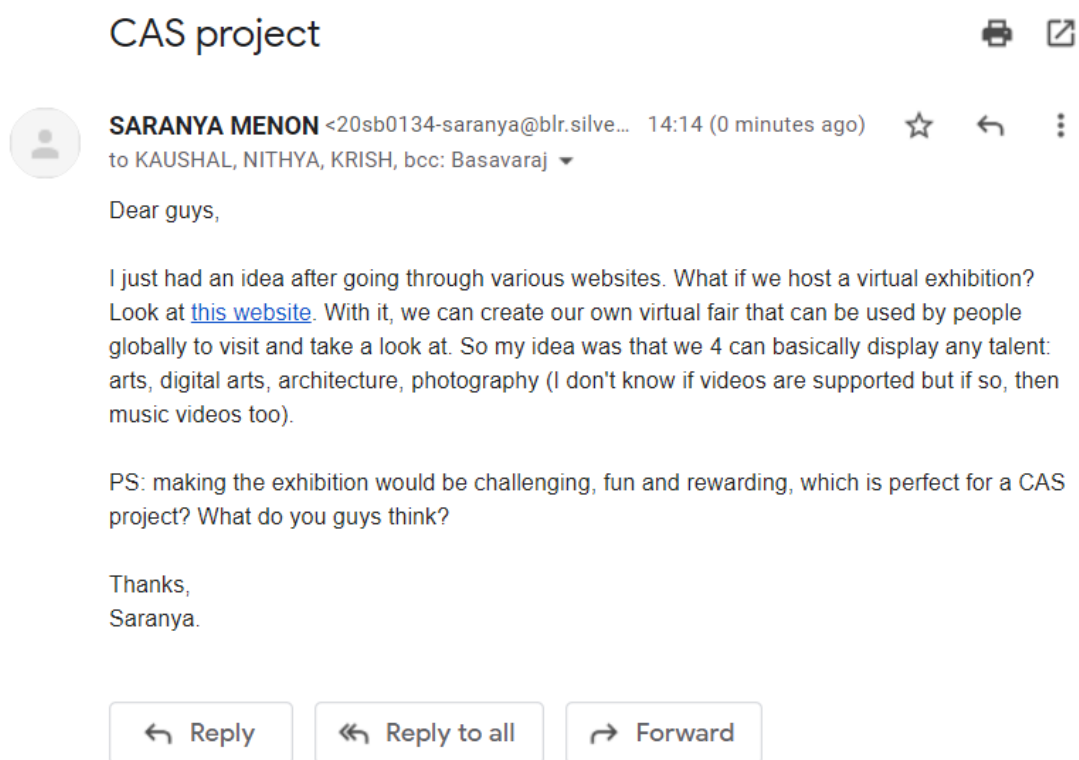
- Write a book (if we write about something helpful then it will be creativity and service).

- Get in touch with a government school and ask if you can build a library/any facility.



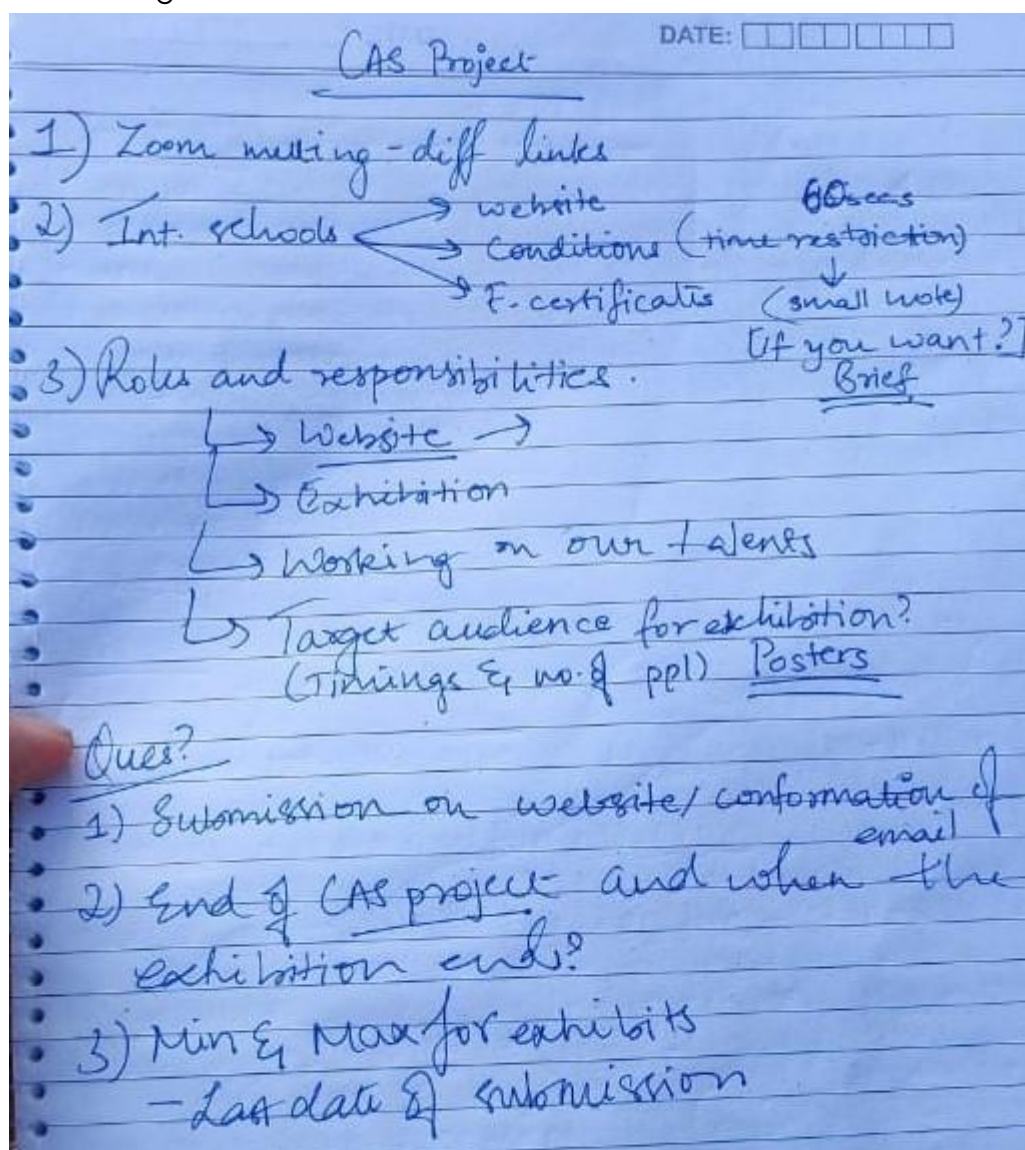
16-01-21:

To-do list:

- ★ FOURTH: Figure out how many schools and how many submissions need to be accepted. Also find out the date the exhibition is to be held, along with the number of people attending to see the exhibit. ✓
- ★ FIFTH: Set up the exhibition and do trial runs to ensure no mistakes occur on the actual exhibition date. ✓
