### THE GIGANTIC BALL OF GAS

Jupiter is the fifth planet from the sun and is located beyond the four rocky planets:-Mercury, Venus, Earth and Mars. Jupiter, a gas giant, is also the largest planet in the solar system with a diameter of 1,42,984 km. Jupiter is 778 million kilometers from the sun—which is equal to the distance of flying 20,000 times around the Earth. Jupiter has the strongest magnetic field, which helps it in holding it's 63 moons together. The asteroids in the asteroid belt between Mars and Jupiter are held in place by the gravitational pull of Jupiter. This prevents the asteroids from flying towards the Earth. A day in Jupiter is only 9 hours and 50 minutes long. This is because Jupiter is the fastest spinner among all the other planets in the Solar System. The time it takes for Jupiter for completing one rotation is know as "Jovian Day" whereas time taken to complete one revolution is known as "Jovian Year". Due to a very large orbit, Jupiter takes roughly 12 years to complete one revolution. The weather on Jupiter is very stormy, near the "Great Red Spot", winds blow at a whooping speed of 400 kilometers per hour! This makes it difficult to send landers on the surface of Jupiter. The Jupiter system is among the most complex systems in the Solar Systems. Among the 63 Moons, the forth largest moon, also known as "Galilean Moon", are the major Moons of Jupiter. These Galilean Moons include LO, Europa, Ganymede and "Callisto". "Ganymede" is the largest moon in the Solar System, with a diameter greater than Mercury and Pluto. "Ganymede" has an icy interior, which gives it it's weak magnetic field. The Galilean Moon closest to Jupiter, Lo, is completely covered with active volcanoes which continuously renew it's surface. The outermost Galilean Moon, Callisto, is a Dark World covered with brilliant white craters. The gravity of Jupiter holds the Galilean as well as other moons of the Jupiter system together. The Jupiter, along with it's moons, from a unique and plays an important role in the amazing Solar System. that awareness
