HOW DO I APPLY?

You don't have to apply specifically for the Career Accelerator Program; all students accepted into the International Accelerator Program at Auburn are eligible to participate. The International Accelerator Program combines the credit-bearing courses of year one of your undergraduate degree with tailored English language and academic support, concierge services and unique American cultural experiences. The Career Accelerator Program begins within the International Accelerator Program and can be completed within four years. WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNSHIP ASSISTANCE?

To be eligible for internship placement assistance, students must: successfully complete all required elements of the Career Accelerator Program, have at least a 3.3 GPA, and have maintained appropriate immigratio status. Once students begin the program, they will have access to advisors who will help them to successfully navigate these requirements.
