ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Grand Valley welcomes your application for admission. Here are the required documents:

- Completed international application and \$30 application fee
- Official, original academic transcripts and degree certificates from all secondary schools and universities that you have attended
- English proficiency requirement
 - TOEFL: 80
 - IELTS: 6.5
 - PTE: 53
 - Completion of ELS 112 (undergraduate and selected graduate programs)
- Native English speakers need to take the SAT or ACT for admission
- Financial verification form with bank statement

FOR GRADUATE APPLICANTS

In addition to the requirements listed above, some of the graduate programs may have additional admission requirements. You can find the complete list of requirements for graduate admission at gvsu.edu/gradapplicantsreq/.
