

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have obtained at least 70% in their 12th (or equivalent).
- Valid IELTS Score of 6.0 overall with no band less than 6.0 or equivalent, or TOEFL of overall 69 with writing not less than 21, or PTE of overall 50 with no individual band less than 50.
- No prior refusal of any visa for Australia.
- Meet the GTE requirements as described by the Department of Home Affairs.
- Students need to secure a minimum weighted average mark of 60% in the first year at Great Lakes Institute of Management to proceed to Deakin University, Australia for Years 2 and 3.

1st Year at Great Lakes Institute of Management

Tuition Fee: **7,50,000** INR Hostel Fee: **2,50,000** INR

2nd & 3rd Year at Deakin University

Estimated tuition fee: **35,800** AUD per year

* The estimated tuition fee is given as a guide based on a typical enrollment of students undertaking the first year of this course. The cost can vary based on the units you choose, your study load, and the time you take to complete the course.
