SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

UNDERGRADUATES

We offer the International Merit Scholarship to qualified students and this scholarship is worth \$5,000 per academic year. Scholarship decisions are made by committee and are based on a review of the information in the application, including an essay, academic information, and extracurricular activities. Students who submit an application for fall admission by May 1 are eligible for this scholarship. Only students on F1 status are eligible for this scholarship.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Grand Valley welcomes your application for admission. Here are the required documents:

- Completed international application and \$30 application fee at gvsu.edu/internationalapp/.
- Official, original academic transcripts and degree certificates from all secondary schools and universities that you have attended
- · English proficiency requirement
 - TOEFL: 80
 - IELTS: 6.5
- PTE: 53
- Completion of ELS 112 (undergraduate and selected graduate programs)
- Native English speakers need to take the SAT or ACT for admission
- · Financial verification form with bank statement

PERSONAL STATEMENT

You must write a one- to two-page essay on your goals and reasons for wanting to attend Grand Valley. Required for undergraduate and selected graduate programs.

FOR GRADUATE APPLICANTS
