Individual aptitude and interests get overlooked

The subject choice prevents admission to certain courses, colleges and countries

Scored 91% in Class 10 (CBSE)

Wanted to study Business Management abroad

Selected Commerce subjects but ignored Mathematics


Didn't know that without

Result

Unable to get his desired college courses, had to settle for a second option

Result

Did not get into her most preferred colleges due to fierce competition with students who had studied Economics or Psychology
