

Kasturba Medical College:

Kasturba Medical College, Manipal (KMC) is a medical college based in Manipal, Udupi District Karnataka, India. Established by T.M.A. Pai on 30 June 1953, KMC was the first self-financing medical college in India. Today, students from 44 countries have graduated from KMC, and the medical degree (MBBS) is recognized worldwide, including by the General Medical Council, ECFMG, Australian Medical Council and Malaysian Medical Council among several others. KMC was under the purview of the Mangalore University.

It is ranked No 2 among the top Indian Medical Schools in South Zone.

Course Name: MBBS

Eligibility:

Pass in 10+2, A level, IB, American 12th grade or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together.

Admission Procedure:

Admissions will be done on the basis of the valid rank obtained in the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET).

The entrance exam NEET which will be held by CBSE in the month of May. Those who qualify by getting NEET Cutoff Score have to attend the NEET counseling on the given date. Applicants have to apply online and mention the preffered college name, academic marks details, name, email id, mobile number and other mandatory information. If the board find that contenders are eligiblir for their mention college, they will allot the seat to that postulant. If not the students have to try for next preference.

Tution Fees:

Tuition Fees: 4,555,000

Fees are subject to change without notice. The fees at the time of admission is the actual fees payable. Disputes, if any, will be redressed under the University rules and regulations.

** In addition to the fees Caution deposit (refundable) of Rs.10,000/- will have to be paid along with the first year course fees.





Cut offs for Kasturba Medical College:

KMC Manipal does not declare a set cut off for its admissions. Counseling is done and seats are allotted on the basis of merit (rank obtained in NEET).

Last year, students who secured NEET All India ranks within 11000 were accepted into KMC Manipal and those with ranks up to 13000 got into KMC Mangalore.

This should give you a rough estimate of what to expect although cut offs may vary this year.

From last year scenario the cut off for Manipal campus may be around 490's, to certainly secure a seat one must score 500 and above in NEET.
