**A) ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION:**

**1. B.Sc. in Nursing: 4 years duration.**

Minimum Qualification for Admission: Pass in

- (i) Pre-University examination conducted by the department of Pre-University **OR**  
 (ii) Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course) **OR**  
 (iii) Senior School Certificate Examination, Pre-degree Examination (10+2) **OR**  
 (iv) An Equivalent with 12 years of Schooling from a recognized Board or University

(With Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English with a minimum of **45%\*** aggregate)

**2. B.Sc. in Radiography: 3 years duration.**

Minimum Qualification for Admission: Pass in

- (i) Pre-University examination conducted by the department of Pre-University **OR**  
 (ii) An Equivalent examination recognized by the NIMHANS, Bangalore **OR**  
 (iii) Job Oriented Diploma course from a recognized Board with Diagnostic Radiography as vocational subject or Equivalent

(With Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology & English with a minimum of **45%\*** aggregate)

**3. B.Sc. in Anaesthesia Technology: 3 years duration.**

Minimum Qualification for Admission:

Pass in Two year Pre University Examination or equivalent with a Science group having secured an aggregate of **45%\*** in Science subjects

**\*40% in case of SC/ST Candidates for B.Sc. courses.**

**Selection of Candidates for courses from 1 to 3 will be based on the marks obtained by the Candidate in the Online Entrance Test. A common Online Entrance Test will be conducted for all B.Sc. courses. The Entrance Test will be followed by counseling. Verification of all the original documents pertaining to eligibility will be done at the time of counseling. No candidates will be offered admission without the original eligibility certificates. Candidates not attending counseling will not be considered for admission at NIMHANS.**

**4. Diploma in Clinical Neurophysiology Technology (DCNT): 2 years duration.**

Minimal Qualification:

B.Sc. with Physics/Electronics/Computer Science with minimum Second Class in the qualifying examination or Diploma in Electronics/Electrical/Instrumentation/Computer (Approved by Board of Technical Education) or 3 years experience as EEG Technician after PUC. **Selection to this course is based on the performance of the Candidate in the Interview.**

**5. Post Basic Diploma in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing & Post Basic Diploma in Neurosciences Nursing:**

Should be a registered Nurse (R.N&R.M) in the State Nursing Council with one year experience as staff nurse. **Selection to these courses will be based on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Director.**

**6. Certificate Course in Neuropathology Technology: 1 year duration.**

Minimal Qualification:

B.Sc. MLT / B.Sc. Life Sciences / DMLT (with one year experience) with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

**B) FEES/RESERVATION OF SEATS:** Please refer Prospectus/website for full details. **2 Seats in B.Sc. in Nursing and 1 Seat in Post Basic Diploma in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing are earmarked for PWD Candidates (Hearing impairment (HH) & Locomotor disability (OH-OL) only). If there are no eligible candidates under this category, the seats will go to the General Candidates in the order of merit.**

### C) INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Application forms for all the courses are available online at the NIMHANS website [www.nimhans.ac.in](http://www.nimhans.ac.in). **The applications have to be filled online and submitted online. APPLICATIONS WITH ENCLOURES WILL BE RECEIVED ONLINE ONLY. ABSTRACT NEED NOT BE SENT SEPARATELY.**
2. A candidate can apply for a maximum of 3 courses only, provided they are eligible.
3. **The application fee is Rs.1000/- per course for General candidates & Rs.750/- per course for SC/ST candidates. The payment is to be made online only with Debit/Credit Cards and/or online transfer. Other mode of payment including Demand Draft will not be accepted at any cost.**
4. Foreign Nationals are required to submit their applications through the Diplomatic Channel (through the Ministry of External Affairs). Sponsored candidates should submit their application through proper channel. The candidates should produce the sponsorship certificate in the prescribed format.
5. **AGE LIMIT:** The age of candidates for all B.Sc. courses should be between minimum of 17 years and maximum of 25 years as on 01.08.2017.
6. Online availability of application forms : 5<sup>th</sup> May 2017
7. Last date for online submission of Application : 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017
8. Online Entrance Test will be held in all the centers on : 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017
9. Merit list of the qualified candidates will be announced on : 27<sup>th</sup> June 2017
10. The date of counseling : 7<sup>th</sup> July 2017
11. Commencement of Courses : 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017
12. Last date for admission of candidates to all the courses : 8<sup>th</sup> August 2017

### D) GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE ENTRANCE TEST:

The Entrance Test will be held online (i.e., computer based). The four cities identified for conduct of ON-LINE Entrance Test in the year 2017-18 are BENGALURU, CHENNAI, COCHIN and HYDERABAD. There may be multiple test centers in these cities and NIMHANS reserves the right to distribute applicants to any test center. A candidate has to select three cities, for taking examination, in the order of priority, i.e., 1<sup>st</sup> choice, 2<sup>nd</sup> choice and 3<sup>rd</sup> choice. However, the choice of City for taking examination, or center in a given city, cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Under exceptional circumstances like lack of minimum number of applicants for a given center in a given city, NIMHANS reserves the right to cancel the choice of city / center.

A mock test demo will be hosted on the NIMHANS website 15 days prior to the Online Entrance Test. The Online Entrance Test will be conducted on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017 at all the four Test Centers.

In the event of unforeseen problem/force majeure, a re-exam will be held at a later date only for those who attended the abandoned exam. NIMHANS reserves the right to decide whether the re-exam relates to one or more cities, or one or more center, or one or more courses.

Possession/use of Mobile Phones/Electronic Devices/Spy Cameras/ Bluetooth is strictly prohibited on the premises of NIMHANS Entrance Test centers and candidates shall be liable for penal action for any such act.

All the Candidates applying for admission to any course at NIMHANS, should give a declaration stating that **"I HAVE ALL THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND I AM APPLYING FOR THE COURSES AT NIMHANS AND AT ANY GIVEN POINT OF TIME, IF FOUND THAT I HAVE GIVEN WRONG INFORMATION, MY CANDIDATURE CAN BE CANCELLED WITHOUT CONSIDERATION FOR THE COURSES AT NIMHANS. I ALSO SUBSTANTIATE MY CLAIM BY ATTACHING NECESSARY CERTIFICATES WHEREVER APPLICABLE"**.

Eligible candidates must take printout of their Admit Card for the Entrance Test from NIMHANS website only. Admit Card will not be sent by post. List of qualified candidates for interview/counseling will be notified on the Institute's Notice Board and Website. No separate individual intimation will be given. The decision of the Director in all matters regarding selection will be final and no representation in any form will be entertained. The candidate must visit the website from time to time for all necessary details and updates on the above.

Incomplete applications, applications without the mandatory attachment will be rejected. Applications without sufficient payment will also be rejected. The application fee of the rejected applications will not be refunded at any cost. No communication will be given in respect of rejected applications. No interim enquiry or correspondence will be entertained. List of selected candidates will be notified on the Institute's Notice Board and Website. The decision of the Director in all matters regarding selection will be final and no representation in any form will be entertained.
