Answer: You will receive your Trial account login credentials on the email registered with the school before the Univariety Launch in your school.

Note: Trial account have limited functionality. Students will not get access to counselor-on-chat, alumni conversation and 8 psychometric test.

Q3. Does the parent also get a Univariety account along with the student?

Q3. How does Univariety support me in my search for careers and colleges?

Answer: Univariety supports students through 4 different areas of exposure:

- A **research ecosystem** to search information around
 - Careers
 - Colleges
 - Scholarships
 - Entrance Tests
- **Expert Counselors** that are available 24*7 to answer any questions that a student has. The counselors have an combined expertise derived from more than 2,00,000 student success stories across the last 8 years
- Analytics from a **combined alumni database** of more than 500 schools and more than 3,00,000 student case studies apart. This is in addition to school wise alumni video case studies and platform to ask questions to alumni in real-time
- **University interactions** (Both individual and group based) which allows students to ask questions and get updates straight from experts and University representatives

Apart from the 4 pillars of support, Univariety also assists students with webinars on a weekly basis where Experts and University representatives connect live with students. This is in addition to tools such as Course Fee Calculator, Country Comparision, Ideal College Lists and System based recommendations on colleges, scholarships and entrance tests.

Q4. How often do I need to use the Univariety platform?

Answer: There is no minimum or maximum number of usage that students need to keep in mind. For students who have a career in mind, use the platform to research career alternatives and look at webinars to see what experts are suggesting. Students can also look at alumni career planning journeys and learn from that experience

For students who have not thought of a career yet, start by taking a self-assessment to get an insight into your likes and dislikes. You can follow that up by speaking to a counselor.



Parent Login

Q1. Where does a parent login?

Answer: A parent account gets activated once the student account has been upgraded from Trial to Paid. Parent can access the parent account **only** via the Univariety app. To download the Univariety app, please use the following links:

Q2. How does a parent login?

Answer: A parent account needs to be created by the parent. The 2 pre-requisite for creating your own parent account are,

- **Univariety App** (Please refer the previous question to download the Univariety app)
- **Student Code** (Every paid student account has a Student Code. Please reach out to Univariety at schoolconnect@univariety.com in case you need assistance with setting up your parent account)

Validity

Q1. How long is the Trial account valid for?

Answer: The trial account is created 15 days before the Univariety launch in your school and is valid for 15 days after that. For Billabong High International School, Malad the expiry date is **3 February 2019 (till 9 PM)**

Q2. What happens once the Trial account expires?

Answer: You can reach out to Univariety (schoolconnect@univariety.com) or to your school to upgrade from the Trial account and get all the benefits of the univariety platform (for student and parents)



Upgrading from a trial account

Q1. How does one upgrade from a trial account?

Answers: At any point in the Trial period, you can upgrade your account by clicking on the Upgrade button on the Home Page of your students Univarsity account.

The cost of the Univarsity account is INR 2950 (inclusive of taxes) per student.

Q2. What is the validity of the paid student and parent account?

Answer: The paid student and parent account are valid for 365 days from the time and date of payment. The account has to be renewed after 365 days, for which the pricing will increase annually by 7.6%.

Payment

Q1. What are the various payment modes available for a parent?

Answer: Payments to activate the complete Univarsity account can be done in 2 ways:

- **From within the student Univarsity trial account:** At any point in the Trial period, you can upgrade your account by clicking on the Upgrade button on the Home Page of your students Univarsity account. This will take you to the payment gateway from where payment can be made.

- **Online mode outside the student Univarsity trial account:** You can alternatively pay via PayTM. To do this, follow the steps:
 - Open the PayTM app on your phone



- Search for Fees
- Select Institute Location as **Hyderabad**
- Select Institute as **Univariety**
- Select Service as **School Service**
- Fill up the requisite information
- Please put the Fee as INR 2950 and complete the payment process
