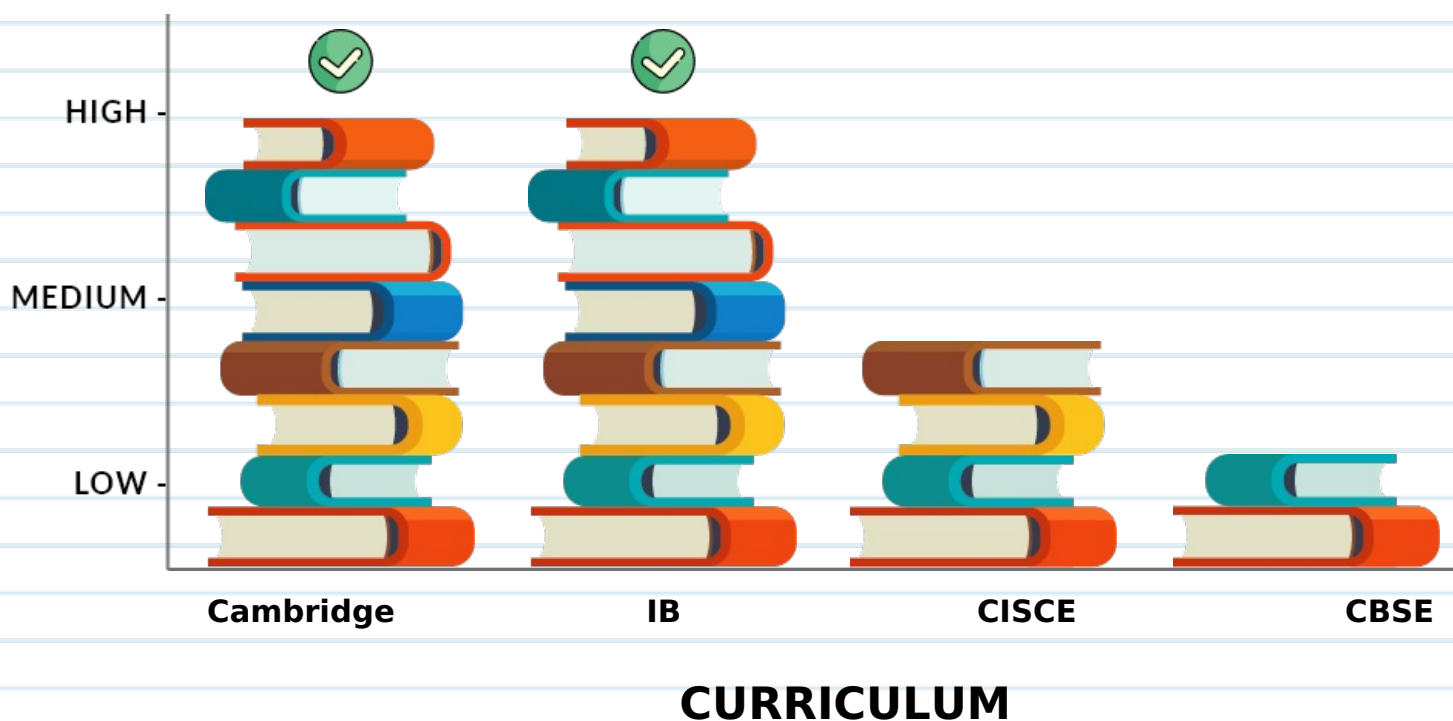

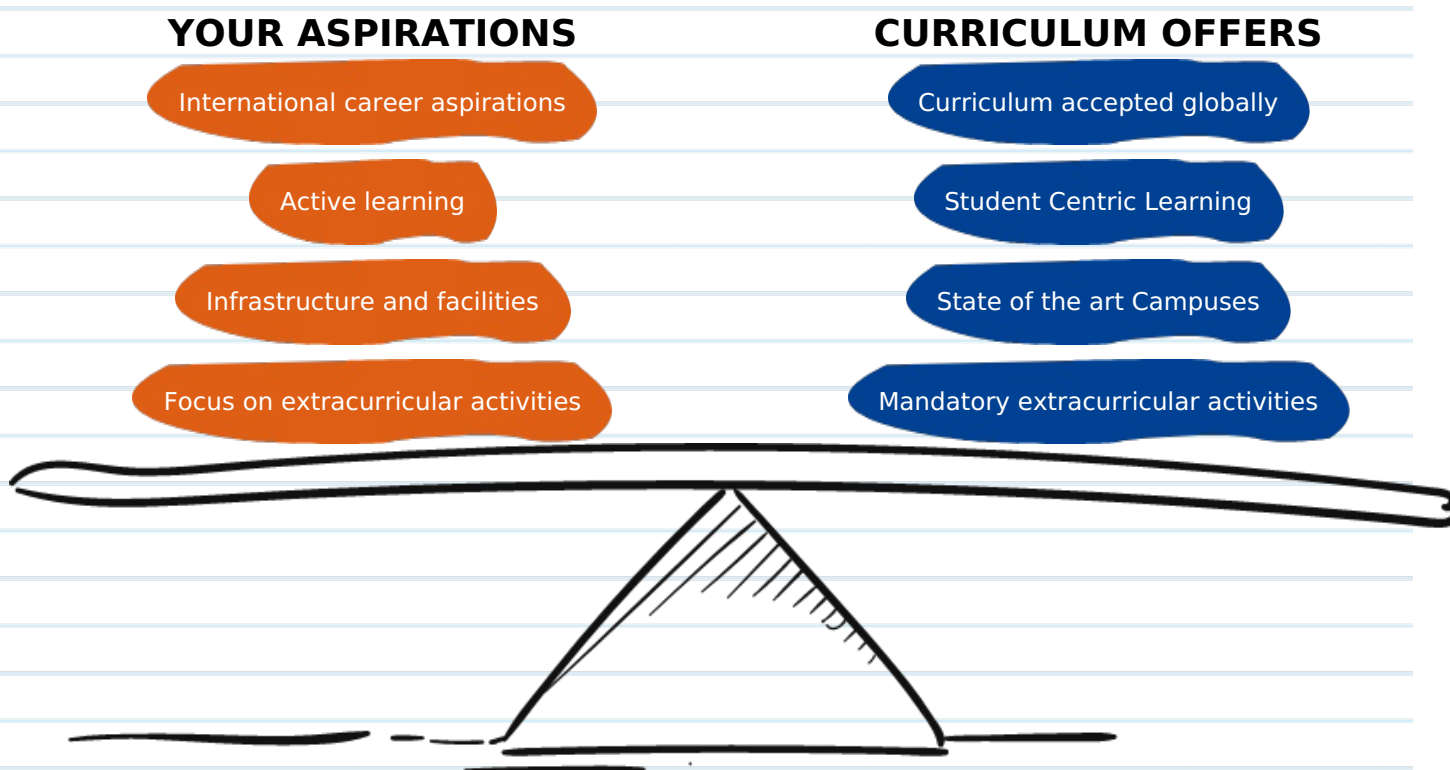

CISCE: Indian Certificate of Secondary Education

Established in 1958, the CISCE, also known as The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations is a national level private education board. The CISCE conducts examinations for Grade 10, called the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) and also for Grade 12, called the Indian School Certificate (ISC).
