## **Explanatory Notes**

This statement of results is not a certificate. The University of Cambridge International Examinations reserves the right to amend the information given on this statement, which will be confirmed by the issue of certificates.

ICE is awarded in three categories: Distinction, Merit and Pass, to candidates who satisfy certain conditions as stated in the regulations.

IGCSE results are reported on an 8-point scale of grades:  $A^*(a^*)$ , A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) or G(g), grade  $A^*(a^*)$  being the highest and grade G(g) the lowest. UNGRADED indicates a standard below that required for grade G(g).

GCE O Level (Ordinary Level) results are reported on a 6-point scale of grades: A\*(a\*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d) or E(e), grade A\*(a\*) being the highest and grade E(e) the lowest. UNGRADED indicates a standard below that required for grade E(e).

NO RESULT indicates that a result cannot be issued because of absence for the whole or part of the examination in the syllabus or because of a decision not to issue a result for some other reason.

PENDING indicates that a result cannot be issued at present but will follow in due course.

TO BE ISSUED indicates that the results will be issued in the November session.

The assessment of Oral/Aural communication is compulsory in IGCSE English as a Second Language syllabus 0510 and 0511. In IGCSE First Language syllabuses and Afrikaans as a Second Language syllabus 0548 the assessment of Speaking & Listening communication is optional. Except for IGCSE English as a Second Language syllabus 0511, these components are assessed separately and the results are reported on a 5-point numerical scale, grade 1(ONE) being the highest and grade 5(FIVE) the lowest. Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard for grade 5(FIVE) will not receive an Oral/Aural (Speaking & Listening) communication endorsement. The endorsement grade for Oral/Aural (Speaking & Listening) communication will be recorded on IGCSE certificates provided the overall IGCSE syllabus result in the subject concerned is grade G(g) or higher.

The Percentage Uniform Mark provided for IGCSE and GCE O Level supplements the grade for a syllabus. The Percentage Uniform Mark recorded is generated according to a common scale for all subjects to show relative performance. A Percentage Uniform Mark is not generated for a syllabus that is Ungraded, No Result, Pending or To Be Issued.

Only grades A\*(a\*) to G(g) attained in IGCSE and A\*(a\*) to E(e) in GCE O Level subjects will be recorded on certificates.

Only Distinction, Merit and Pass attained in the ICE Award will be recorded on certificates.
